Today's topic, **The Burning Questions**, raises issues including changing time zones, removing poker machines and toll roads.

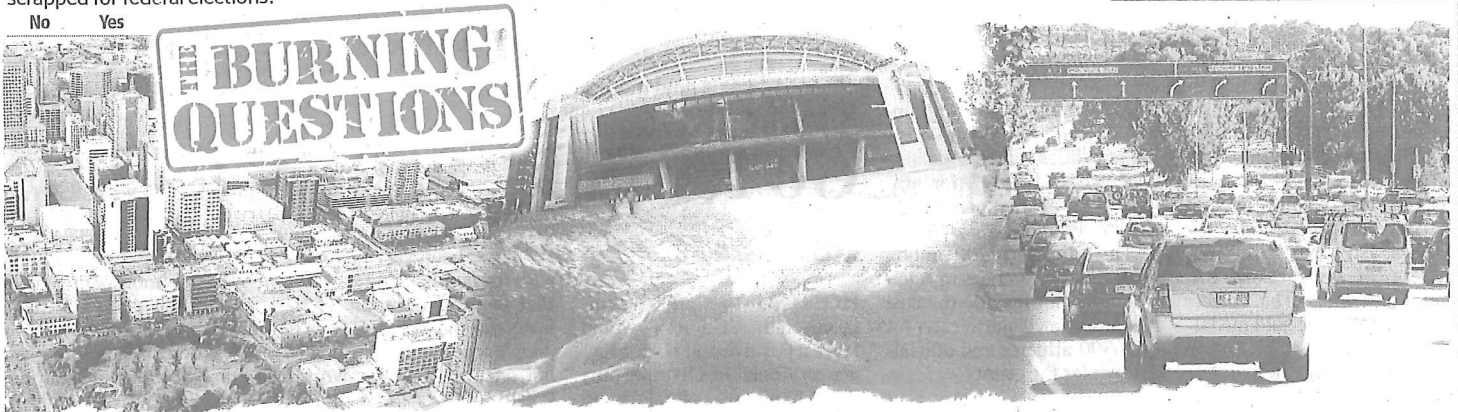
