- Is there a book like Yates Garden Guide available for our local area? Could this be my outcome?

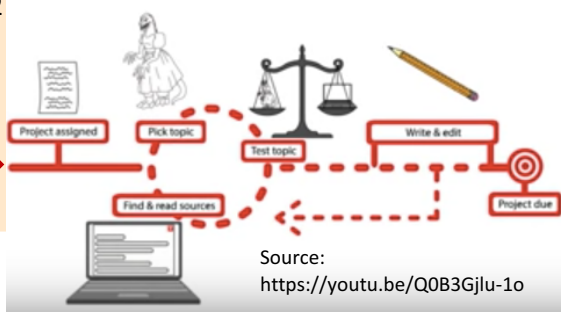
To do list brainstorm (photo from whiteboard)
